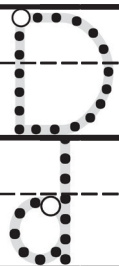

Unscramble the words and write the sentence. If you need help unscrambling, you can cut out the words and move them around.


